 - Budget Advisory Board report:
 - Enrollment increase 1.2%
 - Slight tuition increase 2-3% (3% MAX, still a lower increase than most institutions)
 - Student Activities fee + 1.00/credit hour
 - Technology fee + 1.00/hour
 - Scholarship change:
 - 5 tiers
 - Level 4&5 have ACT component (per faculty request), limited
 - On campus/off campus amount differences (receiving more money if on-campus)
 - Anticipating possible Arkansas Challenge increase starting at \$2,000 for freshman
 - Looking at possibly rebuilding the fleet (slowly)
 - A lot of what our budget looks like next year will depend on state and federal legislation
 - Still looking at Constitutional revisions
 - April 4th, 8th, 9th or April 30th, May 1st, May 2nd for in-person VPSAEM interviews

- Dean of Student Engagement – Kevin Solomon
 - Report: Budget Advisory meetings will be posted on the website
 - Board meeting is in April, increases and fees will be posted. Res life fee was increased at 2.48% avg increase
 - Wifi was 400,000 dollars and upkeep is expensive as well due to state increases.
 - 780,000 dollar increase in energy bills for ATU as a whole
 - Student Activity fee funds campus life in numerous ways. The one dollar increase raises around 100,000 dollars. This increase will be to pay student workers at the new student union.
