- 7. Students, Faculty, Staff, and the Community will be able to vote on their favorite sculpture. A Community Choice Award will be given to the sculpture with the most votes. A vote will be counted as one food item donated or one dollar. Voting for the community choice award will take place Thursday, February 28th between 3-4 pm.
- 8. Winners will be announced on Thursday, February 28th at 4:30 pm
- 9. Student Organizations are responsible for checking "expired" dates on food prior to delivery.
- 10. Student organizations may not remove labels from canned food items but may use paper to cover the labels.
