WHEREAS: Many other campuses have this exact type structure in place, and it has shown to be very successful in energizing Homecoming efforts, and

WHEREAS: This would also remove SGA for having a mandatory official role. And allow the Secretary of Student development to focus on the SGA Retreat planning as well as the Engaged Leaders Institute, and
