### **Bill to amend Article IV, Section 1, Part A & B of the Student Government Association Constitution**

**Whereas,** Article IV, Section 1, Part A currently reads “Petitions of the candidates shall be submitted to the Election Commission of the Student Government Association, which shall set the date for such,” and

**Whereas,** Article IV, Section 1, Part B currently reads “The petitions shall contain the candidate’s name, the office for which the candidate desires to run, and the signatures of at least twenty-five (25) full-time students at Arkansas Tech who are from the body which the candidate is seeking to represent,” and

**Whereas,** This policy has not been in practice for years, and

**Whereas,** The constitution should accurately represent the policies and procedures of SGA, and

**Therefore, be it enacted the Senate of the Student Government Association of Arkansas Tech University:**

Article IV, Section 1, Part A & B will be amended to accurately represent the current practice of SGA, and

**Be it further enacted,** Article IV, Section 1, Part A shall read “Application of the candidates shall be submitted electronically through theLink on the SGA organization page,” and

**Be it further enacted,** Article IV, Section 1, Part B shall read “The petitions shall contain the candidate’s name, the office for which the candidate desires to run, and a candidate bio in which they describe campus involvement as well as why they are running for office.”
