Statistical analysis of the reasons for success or failure in ACCT 2003 has shown that, since the spring 2011 semester, students who have successfully passed BUAD 2003 and MATH 2223 or 2243 have found greater success in ACCT 2003. COMS 1003 did not provide sufficient software preparation in Excel, and MATH 1113 alone did not cover key areas needed. Specifying MATH 2223 or 2243 will incorporate the need for passage of MATH 1113 or its equivalent as a prerequisite.

When semester schedules were changed to include end of course examinations as part of the required hours of faculty-student content several years ago, this decreased the weeks available for students to complete the required work hours for RP 4116 Internship. It is difficult for students to complete all internship requirements in 15 weeks. Reducing the weeks and hours required to 14 and 560 will allow more students to complete RP 4116 Internship on time.

The faculty recently added assignments to the RP 4116 Internship requirements. Adding language to the course description will help alert students that these assignments should be taken seriously and completed in a professional manner.
