

FACULTY MEETING

ELECTION OF 2003-04 STANDING COMMITTEES

A faculty meeting is scheduled for April 23, 2003, from 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in Pendergraft Library and Technology Center, Room 325, for the purpose of electing faculty standing committees for the 2003-04 academic year.
