

FACULTY MEETING

ELECTION OF 2004-05 STANDING COMMITTEES

A faculty meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 20, 2004, in Pendergraft 323 for the purpose of electing faculty standing committees for the 2004-05 academic year. The election will be conducted by the Faculty Senate following established procedures. A slate of nominees for each committee (nominated by School faculty and by Faculty Senate) follows.
