- Coordinate council officer transition and chapter officer training.
- Coordinate the registered student organization process for all councils.
- Oversee the execution of the Fraternity and Sorority Life Chapter Standards Program.
- Work on special projects, such as recognition, scholarship promotion, publications, outreach, and marketing.
- Assist with the planning and implementation of IFC and Panhellenic recruitments.
- Serve as an educational resources to students and parents interested in Greek Life.
- Oversee New Member Education Certification Program.

## RENUMERATION & QUALIFICATIONS:

The minimal requirements for a candidate seeking this assistantship opportunity is a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, admittance to the Arkansas Tech University graduate school as a master's degree seeking graduate student, a completed background check, and availability to begin working July 6, 2020.

This position pays a stipend of \$1,060 monthly. In addition, 18 hours of graduate credit tuition is covered per year.
