

Want more parking? Well according to Arkansas Tech News, that is exactly what will be happening this summer!!

Arkansas Tech University took the first step toward creating **426 new parking spaces** on its Russellville campus during the institution's Board of Trustees meeting on Thursday.

Trustees approved a plan to construct a new 119-space parking lot north of the Arkansas Tech baseball field and a new 307-space parking lot west of Turner Residence Hall on Glenwood Ave.

The new lots will more than offset the loss of the existing Wilson Residence Hall parking lot, which will be the site of construction for a new five-story residence hall due to open in fall 2013. That lot holds 121 cars, so the net gain in parking spaces will be 305.
