

Information About Computer Resource Access

Arkansas Tech University maintains 41 computer labs house across almost every academic building. These labs collectively contain over 1,108 computer workstations. Many computer labs are used as classrooms but are available to students when classes are not in session. Eight labs (158 workstations) are dedicated to students only. The majority of these labs are located in Ross Pendergraft Library and Technology Center.
