Add an area to an existing teaching license

1. Select **Add an area to my license**
2. Select **By Program of Study**
3. Choose **Arkansas Tech University** as your Educator Preparation Program
4. Choose your endorsement area and click **Add Area**. *[See table below for common ATU endorsement Areas. With the list showing, type the corresponding three-digit number. The list will jump to that area.]*
5. Continue through the application until you receive the message **“Your application has been sent to your Educator Preparation Program Coordinator for approval.”**
