

Research and Graduate Studies Student Research Grants Program

Application Instructions

The ATU College of Research and Graduate Studies invites students to submit applications for faculty-mentored independent research across all academic disciplines. Funding includes up to \$2,000 for project support (supplies and travel). Grants are awarded based on merit and subject to committee approval and budget availability.

Completed applications and letters of support should be submitted to grants@atu.edu.

Deadline for 2026-27 Academic Year is Tuesday, September 5th, 2026 at 5:00 PM. All applications must be received by the deadline to be considered.

Eligibility & Requirements

You must:

- Be a currently enrolled ATU student
- Have a faculty mentor with an appropriate research project
- Include a mentoring plan provided by your faculty mentor as part of your proposal
- Demonstrate strong academic performance (GPA considered)

Application Components

1. **Student & Faculty Information:** Contact details, GPA, major, graduate/career plans, and faculty mentor information
2. **Project Proposal:** Title, research question, background, methodology, timeline, and expected outcomes
3. **Mentoring Plan:** Detailed description of faculty guidance throughout the project provided by faculty mentor
4. **Letter of Support:** Letter from faculty mentor the proposed project
5. **Detailed Budget (up to \$2,000):** Itemized breakdown by category (supplies/materials and travel expenses)

Award Conditions

If approved, you must:

- Work under your faculty mentor's supervision throughout the project.
- Follow your approved budget. **Transfers between categories are not allowed after approval.**
- Complete all requisitions when funds are dispersed.
- Comply with ATU travel policies (student travel only; requires department head, dean, and VP approval).
- Submit a revised budget if travel arrangements change after approval.
- Present results at the Annual ATU Scholars Symposium
 - Scholars Symposium Applications Due: **March 15, 2027**
 - ATU Scholars Symposium Date: **April 22, 2027**
- Submit your poster/presentation to ATU's Online Research Commons

Review Criteria

Applications are evaluated by a committee of ATU faculty and administrators based on:

1. Quality of student applicant (GPA and potential for graduate education/research career)
2. Scientific or academic merit of proposed research
3. Appropriateness of scope for completion within the grant period

- Any other financial support you are receiving (departmental, college, university, external)
- Their commitment to the success of the project
